

Emergency Closure

In extreme circumstances out of our control, Whitsers may have to close during or prior to the start of a session for one of the following reasons:

- Adverse weather conditions where staff are unable to reach Playgroup or deteriorating conditions during a session mean closing early to enable children and staff to reach home safely before travel becomes impossible
- Contingency staff are unable to work to cover staff sickness/absence. Please refer to "Contingency Staffing Procedure" policy
- Heating failure where the temperature drops below 15 degrees and stays under that temperature for a long period
- Electricity/water failure
- Flood/fire
- Emergency building work
- High rate of infectious disease
- Accident which involves the Health & Safety Executive
- Any other eventualities that the committee and Play Leader deem necessary.

In all cases we will aim to give parents/carers and staff as much notice as we can, but be aware that sometimes this may not be possible.

If we have to evacuate the building during a session, our safe meeting area will be:

Parents will be contacted according to the emergency contact information they have provided on registering their child. Staff and any available Committee will call parents / guardians / carers as swiftly as possible and appropriate numbers of staff or Committee will remain until all the children have been collected by a recognised carer.
